Numerator (i)

Rejects are excluded from gate of reprocessor (Q19 and Q35)

Denominator

1. Total tonnages of recycling/reuse/composting received in Q16.

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Material rejected is not deducted as this is part of the total municipal waste arisings.



2. Total tonnage of residual waste CA site waste (household and non-household) from Q23

This calculations does not take into account any residual waste recorded in Q23 on WDF that is subsequently sent for recycling/reuse*.
